Program Description

Parents as Teachers (PAT) is an evidence-based home visiting program designed to build strong communities, thriving families and children who are healthy, safe and ready to succeed. PAT services include:

- 1. Personal Visits at least twice monthly
- 2. Monthly Group Connections with other PAT families
- 3. Screenings and Assessments to identify developmental concerns
- 4. Connections to Outside Resources that families may need to succeed

Jasper County First Steps serves families in greatest need. Among our PAT families:

96% ... live in poverty

57% ... didn't graduate from high school

16% ... were teen parents

This year, our Parents as Teachers program:

- ✓ Averaged 2 home visits per family
- ✓ Identified and addressed XX potential developmental delays, and made 6 (15%) connections for families to services such as BabyNet, and School District Special Education and Child Care Scholarships
- Improved parenting practices through reflective practices and positive modeling during home visits as indicated using Keys to Interactive Parenting Skills
- Improved literacy skills indicated using Adult-Child Interactive Reading Inventory, activities from PAT lessons, 221 of books distributed
